 - a. Irving and Arlington Blvd updates:
 - Mostly for bicycle and pedestrian safety
 - Selected due to accident data
 - Includes ADA ramps, enhances crosswalks, new sidewalks,
 - Design plans have incorporated prior public feedback
 - Mast mounted traffic lights to replace strung lights
 - Additional bus shelters included, and new placement of existing shelters to far side of intersection to enhance traffic flow
 - Pedestrian “cross buttons” will be relocated for accessibility
 - b. Complete Streets Project (5th St to Columbia Pike)
 - 5th Street – changes to crosswalks
 - Bus pads altered to allow full front and rear door access
 - Raised medians provide safer “resting area” when crossing street
 - 8th St South – eliminate the three lane entrance
 - 9th St South – HAWK signal installation
